The Bible is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God.

We believe the scriptures, both Old and New Testaments to be the God-breathed Word of God, infallible and final authority concerning truth, morality, and the proper conduct of humanity. We believe the Scriptures are the whole revelation of God's will for the salvation of humanity, and the divine and final source for all faith and life. We believe in one God, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, eternal in being, identical in nature, equal in power and glory, and having the same attributes and perfections.

The Holy Spirit lives in each Christian from salvation.

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life. The ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ, and to convict the world of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment. The Holy Spirit regenerates, seals, guides, instructs and empowers believers for life and service through a diversity of offices, gifts both natural and supernatural, ministries, activities, and manifestations. God has called His Church to raise up both men and women in discipleship and ministry. We embrace the biblical government of apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers. These ministries have been given by God to men and women of faith, for the equipping of the saints and for edification of the church.

It allows us to follow the example of Jesus, who submitted himself to baptism to "fulfill all righteousness." We also believe that the Lord's Supper (also known as Communion, or Eucharist) is commanded by the Lord Jesus and is therefore to be observed by all believers. Each time we partake of the elements, we proclaim His death until His return.

We believe that every person must be afforded compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with the Scriptures nor the doctrines of the church.
